

As Geographers we will be:

- learning to name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas;
- learning to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

As Musicians we will be:

- using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes;
- playing tuned and untuned instruments musically;

- participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending;

As Scientists we will be:

- identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals;
- identifying carnivores, herbivores and omnivores;
- describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets);
- identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.

In Religious Education we will be talking about:

- the ways in which Buddhists celebrate the festival of **Wesak/Vaisakha**;
- symbols from the natural world associated with Easter (eggs, bunnies, daffodils, etc).

In Computing we will be learning to:
