This will replace the pink slips we send out. We will still follow safeguarding procedures and record the accident in our accident book. If your child bumps their head we will send home a bumped head slip and text you. Of course if your child has a more serious injury we will call you immediately.

Therefore, it is very important that we have all of your details on our system. Do please let us know of any changes to your contact information.
