

In our other Foundation Subjects we will be:

- Using the Rigalo program to learn French; celebrations and festivals;
- In RE we will be looking at how different religions worship and Humanism;
- In music we will be listening to A New Year Carol by Benjamin Britten and preparing for the spring concert and the summer performances.

As historians and geographers, we will be studying The Ancient Maya Civilisation and the Americas through:

- their culture, architecture and customs;
- where they lived (through map work) and by studying the rainforests in the region;
- looking at landscapes, landmarks, climates of these continents:
- looking at their use of maths through number systems and calendars; and
- comparing and contrasting their achievements with other contemporary civilisations (The Aztecs).

In PE, we will be playing rounders, crickets and athletics skills. In the second half of the term, we will have swimming lessons-details to follow before half-term.

As artists and designers, we will be:

- Printing with inks to make Maya Calendars;
- Textiles and Mayan masks; and
- Using ingredients used by the Ancient Maya to learn about healthy eating.
