



As Historians we are learning to:

Use our research skills to find out about an ancient civilisation by studying Ancient Egypt
Compare and contrast life in Ancient Egypt with our modern day life.
What have we learnt from people who lived at this time and the artefacts that have been discovered in the tombs of the Pharaohs.
We will be finding out about the job of an Archaeologist.

As Artists we are learning to:

Sketch images using shading and colour mixing to create images of Spring.
Look at the paintings on the walls of the Pharaoh's tombs and recreate our own images.
Look at the work of the artist Rousseau.

In our **Citizenship** work we will be finding out about a community and what our local community looks like. We will be learning how to help our local community and will consider how we can improve it. We will be learning more about our Capital city. In **Health Education** we will be learning how to be safe with medicines and drugs.

In our **Indoor PE** we will be learning Egyptian dances and practising sequencing moves. Children will learn to put a motif into their dance to create an individual interpretation.
Children will also learn to work with a partner and in a larger group on how to create synchronised movements in a showcase piece.

In **Outdoor PE** we will be practising our striking and field skills and learning the rules of Rounders and cricket. We will be taking part in swimming lessons. We will be developing our athletic skills.

As Scientists we are learning to:

To Study the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects & birds, including some unusual examples like egg-laying mammals & marsupials.
Compare and contrast the lifecycles of flowering and non-flowering plants.
Find out about well-known naturalists & animal behaviourists.
Propagate plants from different parts of the parent plant.

As Geographers we are learning to:

We will be finding out about the location of Egypt on a map of the world.
We will be finding out about the key features and landmarks of Egypt.
We will be learning about the importance of the River Nile.
We will be learning about the population, climate and industries in Egypt.
