Well done to all of our Year 6 children! We were absolutely delighted with our KS2 results this year! They all worked so incredibly hard and we are very proud of **ALL** of the children.

Some highlights included Sam Paulyn achieving a Level 6 in Maths **and** in Grammar and Spelling. Also Charlotte Loe who achieved the first ever Level 6 for Writing in the school.

We also achieved 50% Level 5 in reading and 43% Level 5 in writing! In all subjects our progress was better than expected for two levels progress and at or above 30% for three levels progress

Mrs Aldred and the team have all worked extremely hard, as indeed have all of the staff who have supported the children on their journey to get to this point.

As a reward for all of the efforts of Phoenix class this year, we will be rewarding our Prefects and Playleaders with a trip to bowling next Friday afternoon. This will be followed by a Pool Party for our Year 6 children.
