

As artists we will be looking at the work of Famous European Artists with a particular focus on the work of Vincent Van Gogh. We will be looking at how he has used colour and shading to create the beautiful effects in his work. We hope to combine this with a trip to The National Gallery in London where we will also see Van Gogh's Sunflowers.

In RE we will be learning about Judaism and the life of Moses. We will be learning about Judaism alongside the season of the season of Lent and Easter in the Christian Faith. In the second half of the term we will be learning about Islam and the significance of Holy Places in different faiths.

As sports people we will be having weekly dance lessons. In outdoor PE we will be learning Football skills in the first half term and in the second half of the term we will be practising gymnastics skills.

In PSHE we will be thinking about Keeping Safe in the first half term. This will focus on keeping safe when we are out and about, keeping safe on the internet and safety in the home. In the second half of the term we will be thinking about medicines and drugs and what we need to do to be safe around these.

As computer technicians we will be using computing programmes to digitally communicate with each other and we will use research engines to find out facts about English and topic work.

In Music this half term we will be composing our own music using the glockenspiels. In the second half of term we will be looking at the music of Tchaikovsky and other European composers.

As scientists work this half term we will be learning about Digestion. We will be learning about different parts of the digestive system and how it digests food so that nutrients can be transported around the body. We will also learn about the importance of looking after our teeth and having a healthy diet. We will learn about food groups and how we can achieve a balanced diet.

In the second half of the term we will be learning about the work of different famous Scientists and this will link to our topic work around Europe. We will focus on different famous scientific discoveries and inventions and how these have made a significant impact on our world today.

In French we will be learning how to ask for and order food and the names of different foods along with vocabulary for everyday things. In the second half of the term we will be learning about the weather and how to tell the time.

Our Topic this Half Term is Mountains. As geographers we will be:

- investigating Mountains and their key features and learning vocabulary associated with rivers.
- we will be learning about famous mountains in the UK and around the world.
- the importance of mountains and the leisure industry.
- What happens when avalanches and volcanos cause major incidents.

In the second half of the Spring Term we will be looking at Modern Europe. This will include researching different capital cities, finding out about different cultures and languages and learning about Famous landmarks.
