In Computing we will be learning:

- how to use powerpoint.
- how to use the internet safely to research facts on a topic.
- to organise information for a purpose.
- to adapt work for a target audience.
- to know how to include animations and transitions.

As Musicians we will be:

- listening to and appraising different styles of music
- learning to sing a variety of tunes and songs
- learning and performing songs.

As Artists we will be:

- using a sketchbook to record and capture media explorations and experimentation
- using famous artists as inspiration to re-create artwork
- working as a large group to create a display.
- using our emotions, thoughts and feelings to produce paintings.

As Design Technologists we will be:

- designing purposeful, functional, appealing products based on design criteria
- generating, developing, and communicating ideas through talking, drawing and templates
- selecting and using a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks
- exploring and evaluating a range of existing products.

As Scientists we will be learning to:

- identify the different parts and functions of a plant.
- investigate the conditions required for germination and growing.
- compare and contrast different types of plant.
- categorise flowers according to their requirements.

As linguists we will be learning to:

- recognise snacks
- understand basic opinions around food
- recognise the months of the year
- identify family members
- recognise numbers 21-30.

As Historians we will be considering:

- who were the Vikings and where did they come from.
- sequencing people and events from the Viking era.
- describing some similarities and differences between modes of transport.
- describing some key developments for Viking Longboat construction.
- creating a mini re-telling of how Vikings were successful raiders.

In Religious Education we will be talking about:

- using religious vocabulary to demonstrate understanding of some key features
- comparing beliefs and practices
- identifying some features of initiation ceremonies.

As Geographers we will be considering:

- where Brazil is compared to the UK
- how Brazil's physical features compare to England's.
- what makes England and Brazil's landmarks unique?
- how the human geography of England and Brazil compare.
- how the climate compares.

As Sportspeople we will be learning to:

- sprint effectively
- jump for a distance
- develop and refine different throwing techniques.

As good citizens we will be:

- choosing what happens to my body and to know how to get help with any concerns.
- understand how to keep healthy
- know why it is important to get enough sleep
- understand the importance of good hygiene
