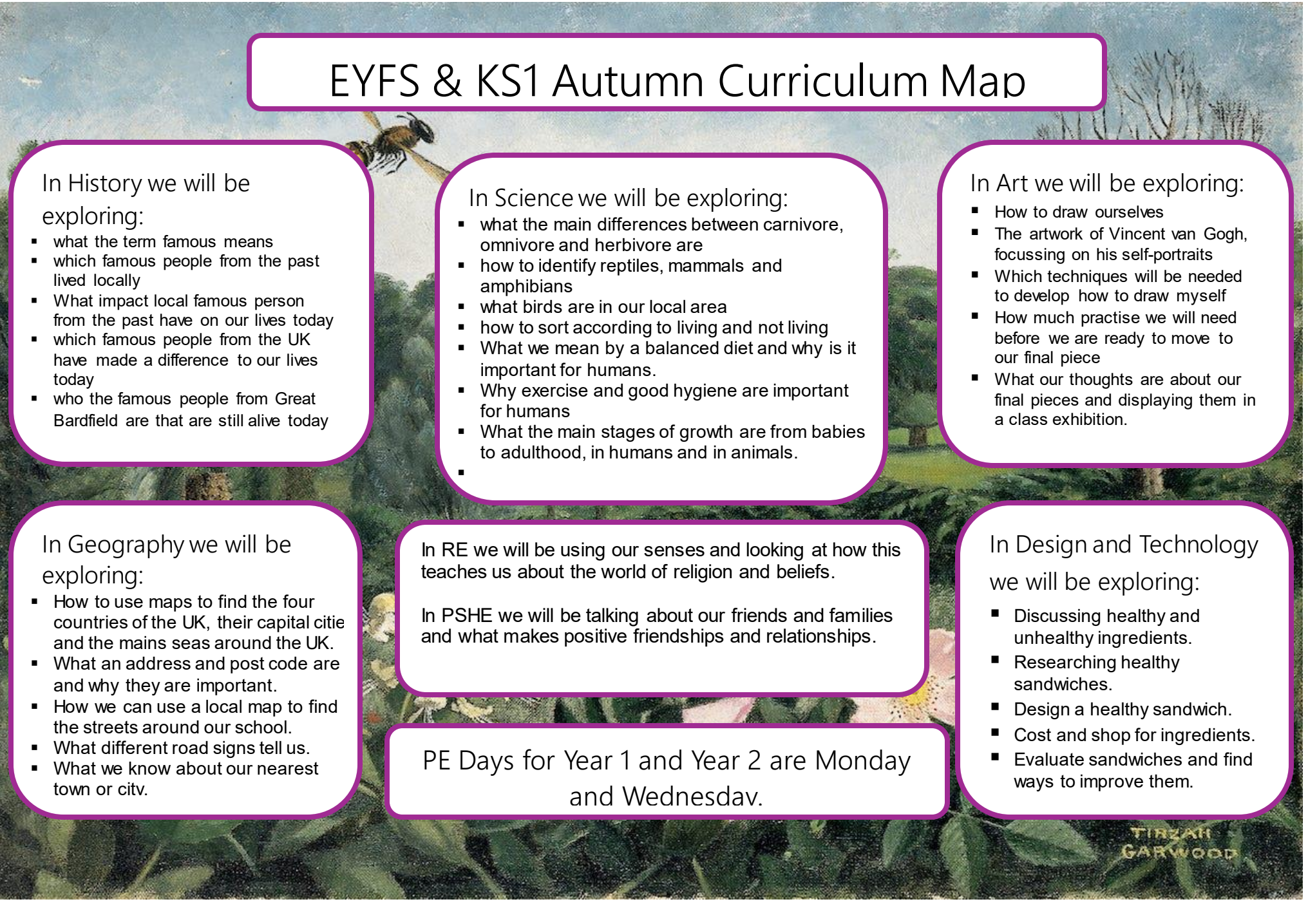




EYFS & KS1 Autumn Curriculum Map

In History we will be exploring:

- what the term famous means
- which famous people from the past lived locally
- What impact local famous person from the past have on our lives today
- which famous people from the UK have made a difference to our lives today
- who the famous people from Great Bardfield are that are still alive today

In Science we will be exploring:

- what the main differences between carnivore, omnivore and herbivore are
- how to identify reptiles, mammals and amphibians
- what birds are in our local area
- how to sort according to living and not living
- What we mean by a balanced diet and why is it important for humans.
- Why exercise and good hygiene are important for humans
- What the main stages of growth are from babies to adulthood, in humans and in animals.

In Art we will be exploring:

- How to draw ourselves
- The artwork of Vincent van Gogh, focussing on his self-portraits
- Which techniques will be needed to develop how to draw myself
- How much practise we will need before we are ready to move to our final piece
- What our thoughts are about our final pieces and displaying them in a class exhibition.

In Geography we will be exploring:

- How to use maps to find the four countries of the UK, their capital cities and the main seas around the UK.
- What an address and post code are and why they are important.
- How we can use a local map to find the streets around our school.
- What different road signs tell us.
- What we know about our nearest town or city.

In RE we will be using our senses and looking at how this teaches us about the world of religion and beliefs.

In PSHE we will be talking about our friends and families and what makes positive friendships and relationships.

In Design and Technology we will be exploring:

- Discussing healthy and unhealthy ingredients.
- Researching healthy sandwiches.
- Design a healthy sandwich.
- Cost and shop for ingredients.
- Evaluate sandwiches and find ways to improve them.
