

EYFS & KS1 Summer Curriculum Map

As historians we will be exploring:

- Know how the telephone changed people's lives and know how they changed over time.
- Know how televisions changed people's lives and know how they changed over time.
- Recognize artefacts used in the home during Victorian times.
- Know how we have adapted the way we use outside space over time.
- Know about the impact that technology has had on our home life.

As scientists we will be exploring:

- Know that a plant needs light, water, air and soil to survive
- Know that trees and shrubs take in water and a gas called carbon dioxide and give out a gas called oxygen
- Know how trees grow from a seed
- Know how important trees are for the environment
- Identify and name trees that are around them.

As artists we will be exploring:

- How to create art from junk.
- The artwork of a range of artists that have used junk modelling.
- Which techniques will be needed to develop our junk modelling skills.
- What to create to make a junk modelling garden.
- What our thoughts are about our final pieces and displaying them in a class exhibition.

As geographers we will be exploring:

- Why we recycle.
- Where all our rubbish goes.
- What we mean by recycling.
- Why plastically is environmentally unfriendly.
- How we can be more environmentally friendly
- How to collect and record data

In **RE** we will be exploring how different religions believe the universe came to be. We will be comparing the Hindu and Christian creation stories.

In **PSHE**:

Year 1 will be learning about relationships and being yourself.

Year 2 will be learning about growing up and changes.

After half term, we will be learning about keeping ourselves safe.

As design technologists we will be exploring:

- About our locality and school and use this as inspiration for our designs.
- How to create an initial design that focuses on gluing different textiles.
- How to gather resources and which resources we will need.
- Evaluate our products against the design criteria.
